ONTARIO ECO-SCHOOLS PROGRAM (www.ontarioecoschools.org)

Ontario Eco-Schools was formed in 2002 when a group of education stakeholders including schools boards, York University and the Toronto and Region Conservation Authority joined together to help expand the work being done by the Toronto District School Board to address environmental issues and concerns in the formal educational curriculum.

Today the Ontario Eco-Schools Program works to improve school building operations in an effort to reduce environmental impacts, with focus on ecological literacy, waste minimization, energy conservation and school ground greening programs.

The Ontario Eco-Schools Program involves students from grades 1 to 12, is supported by resources to enhance the Ontario curriculum expectations and is in alignment with Ministry of Education goals and strategies.

The program allows schools to be certified in three levels: gold, silver or bronze by recognizing schools for their level of environmental initiatives and how effectively they have met the requirements of the program.

The Foundation for Environmental Education offers an international Eco-Schools program that focuses on environmental management and certification. The program is designed to encourage sustainable education in schools, and encourages youth to take an active role in ensuring their school is part of a holistic approach to integrating schools and the environment.

The international Eco-Schools Program currently involves over 32,156 schools in 47 countries worldwide, with over 9 million students and 628,000 teachers participating.
